## YOUTH GROUP NEWS – REALLY

Last Sunday afternoon our youth and their parents met and organized the fall meeting and event schedule. Sean has many exciting events planned for our youth through the end on 2010. We have some new faces in youth group as a result of Camp Olivet and it is our hope that our youth group will continue to grow. In order to have a strong, successful, and growing youth program we need the involvement of many adults in our congregation, especially the parents of our youth. Parents, please be sensitive to the needs of our youth such as chaperones, equipment, meal providing and your ideas for these events. Sean handed out the meeting and event schedule to the parents who attended this meeting but it is not just parents who are needed. Our youth need the entire congregation to get involved. The youth group has at least 3 meals planned before the end of the year and needs people to provide something really simple such as sloppy joes, pizza, spaghetti, grilled cheese sandwiches, really simple things.

Below is a list of just a few items needed in order to make youth meetings and events possible:

Help in providing a minimum of 3 simple meals to our youth between now and December 31st. Dates for these meals are:

October 10 Unbirthday Celebration

November 14 Worship Night

December 19 Secret Santa Holiday Extravaganza

We need **3 or 4 family tents**, big enough to sleep 6-10 people. Tents are needed by the last weekend in September.

We need **firewood** for a youth bonfire on November 7<sup>th</sup>

We need parents to help on September 12 (**help create a spiritual center.**)
